#### **COVID-19 NOW IMPACTING ANNUAL GRAND SESSIONS**

In a little more than a month, the Grand Bodies would normally be opening their Annual Meetings. However, this year none of them are meeting as per usual due to limits placed on the number of persons permitted to gather for indoor functions. Guidelines set to limit the spread of this dangerous virus also limit how our leaders of each of the Grand Bodies can function and those guidelines can change daily, making it extremely difficult to make plans for large gatherings months in advance.

As of this writing, there will be no "in-person" meetings to include delegates for any of our Masonic bodies this year. Current plans for Grand Lodge are to have a much abbreviated session on October 23 to satisfy constitutional requirements. Most business will be conducted via Grandview prior to that date to include reports, legislation, voting, etc. In mid–September more info will be released to the lodges through Grandview. All voting members will have telecommunication access to the session.

Although plans are still incomplete for the Grand Chapter and Grand Council, both bodies will meet on October 7 to satisfy constitutional requirements. Grand Council will have a two hour session in the morning and Grand Chapter two hours in the afternoon. Again, much of the business will be conducted prior to the sessions. It is unclear at this time whether members will have telecommunication access for the actual meetings.

Currently, the Grand Master of the Grand Encampment of Knights Templar who has authority over all the Grand Commanderies has closed down all in person Commandery activity since mid-March. Our Grand Commandery will be having a virtual zoom meeting on October 10. Any Commandery member can register to obtain reports and information relating to the meeting on the Grand Commandery website.

The main concern of each of our Masonic leaders is to protect the safety and well-being of all our members.


